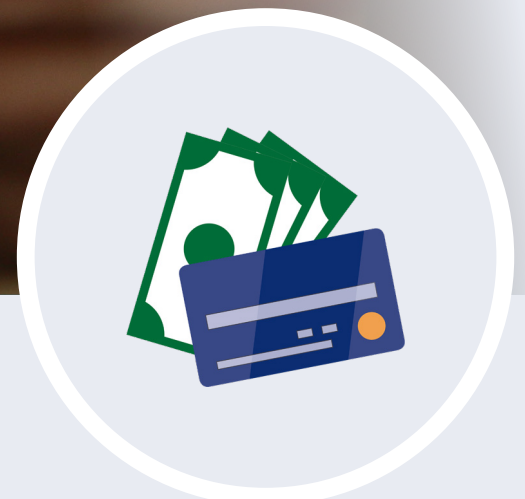

MiniPOS is self-service or staff driven point of sale application that can be run on a PC or touch screen kiosk

The MonitorBM miniPOS offers the ability to prepay for goods, services, donations, fees & fines without staff involvement. This provides greater convenience for customers and eliminates cash handling by staff. Students can pay for specialist printing or copying at a departmental PC or touch screen, for instance. A receipt is printed for the user, or emailed to the technician at the wide format printer. Each miniPOS station can have a unique list of products that can be purchased, depending the site. The user purchases from a menu using a student, library or other ID card. MiniPOS emails the vendor notifying payment and the details of the order. Purchases are then collected or delivered and a receipt is either emailed or printed for them.

How it Works

Step-by-step miniPOS transaction

- The user enters card number and PIN.
- The user selects items from the 'Choose Products' list and confirms with 'ADD'.
- After the user has made their choice, they select 'Confirm' to finish the transaction and debit their account or pay via cash, coin or credit card.
- A detailed receipt will automatically print or can be emailed to the user and to the vendor.
- Purchases are then collected or delivered.
